3. Comments on European Town Meeting:

- **Paris [January 2014]: MMez, DD, MMal, MW, JS**
 - JS reported:
 - Meeting was a success; altogether ~100 people attended, a good outcome for a meeting remote from CERN. Almost all of the important people in the field (in Europe) were there. The meeting was organized over three 3 (intense) days with many presentations and excellent discussions. The round-table

discussion at the end of the meeting was productive and allowed a number of points of agreement to be defined.

- European people are contributing strongly to T2K and US neutrino projects. Proposals for many experiments that could take place in Europe. Also, CERN's potential role was discussed extensively.
- DD (joined the meeting at this point):
 - Emphasised that one interesting point was the presentation of the CERN Neutrino Platform. This was presented in some detail and starts with charged particle beams and has the potential to evolve to include a neutrino beam.
 - A short summary of the meeting has been prepared and is in "final draft" form. We agreed that the summary of the meeting will be circulated to the Neutrino Panel tomorrow (29Jan14).
